### Call for Applications of Thai translations of literary pieces from Central Europe

**Join our project, translate poems and/or short stories into Thai from English or their original language, and be published in a unique literary anthology!**

As part of its Visegrád Group Presidency activities, the Embassy of Hungary – in cooperation with the Embassies of Slovakia, Czechia and Poland, and the Central and Eastern European Studies Section of the Centre for European Studies of Chulalongkorn University – hereby issues a Call for Applications.

Participants are required to choose one or more literary pieces from the poems and short stories listed in the Annexes of this Call, translate it into Thai language based on either the English or the original version, and submit it to the address [mission.bgk@mfa.gov.hu](mailto:mission.bgk@mfa.gov.hu). The application shall include the name of the participant in both Thai and English version, their contact details (phone and email). The subject of the email shall be Central European Literature in Thailand, the translations shall be attached in Word (.doc or .docx) format. Please use the above email address for any procedural or substantial questions about the application.

**Deadline for applications: 1st May 2018**

**The best translations will be published in a multilingual Anthology** – appropriately selected by our cooperating experts.

The cooperating partners wish to invite all friends of Literature and all participants to a **Workshop on Friday, 1st June 2018 at Chulalongkorn University with a seminar on Contemporary Central European Literature**, followed by a **Reception with the official presentation of the Anthology**. Our special guest at the Workshop will be Mr. Dániel Levente Pál, Hungarian poet, writer, editor and professor of literature.

Our project aims at introducing our Central European region's literature to the Thai audience, presenting a colourful picture of topics through the eyes of young, talented and successful authors; and providing a forum for interaction with one of the authors for all our participants and anyone interested in literature or the Central European region.
